

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF RAYMORE-PECULIAR BAND BOOSTERS CLUB, INC.

February 11, 2014

The regular meeting of the Raymore-Peculiar Band Boosters Club was held on February 11, 2014 in the South High School band room. The meeting was called to order at 7:05pm.

Meeting Minutes Approval:

A motion was made by June Harryman to approve the minutes from the January 14, 2014 meeting. John Wilson seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the minutes were approved.

Director's Report – John Wilson

- Mr. Wilson stated Solos and Ensembles are coming on March 28 hosted by Grain Valley. Students should be practicing at least once a week on solos and possibly twice a week if they are in a group. It is too late to do a solo.
- All State went well and we had three students perform at the All State concert at Tan-Tar-A; Logan Jungman, Katie Hatfield, and Rebecca Scott.

- March 3 the Symphonic Band will visit the Intermediate schools. The Symphonic Band will also play with the UCM Wind Symphony (a joint concert) on April 23.
- The Jazz Band has been practicing after school and they sound really good. They are playing for the Black History Month assembly. They will also play on March 1 at the GEM Theatre. They will be traveling to Northwest Missouri State University for contest on Saturday, March 8.
- All three bands are getting ready for contest and they are playing very well.

Communication's Report – Dillon Jarrett

- The upcoming Pep In Your Step information is on the band website, rpbands.com. We are charging a flat \$10 fee per ticket and the convenience fee will come out of our profit.
- We have switched from squarespace to weebly on the backside. All appears to be going well with the switch over.

Treasurer's Report – Sherri Jungman

- The current balance in the checking account is \$6,954.76.
- The current balance in the savings account is \$16,500.49 (student accounts).

- Kurzweil fundraiser money has not been transferred into student accounts as Sherri just received break down sheet. She will get this transferred as soon as possible.

Fundraising Chair Report

- Mr. Wilson spoke regarding a band trailer. The trailer we talked about last time is not road worthy after looking at by the Booster dads. Per Mr. Wilson, kids are excited about a trailer. Logistics still need to be worked out such as who will pull, do we rent a semi, licensing.
- Jeff McDowell located a different trailer and they are asking \$10,000. Jeff's going to offer \$5,000 and see if the business will write off the additional \$5,000. This trailer is a 1991 and it would still need to be outfitted but there are many benefits. The Booster dads will check into this one.
- March 2, 2014 Pep In Your Step. \$10 per person. 4 – 6 PM on Sunday. Money will be used to purchase trailer and other band items that are needed. Mr. Wilson stated we really need to push this event after the Father Daughter Dance is over (which is coming up quick).
- Father Daughter Dance set for Saturday, February 15. It was briefly stated by parents that have been involved in the planning that all appears on track but no chair committee person was present to give any details. It was suggested that we see if a band dad could pull the trailer for the dance. Brian Kincaid and Mike McIntosh are both out of town that weekend. Asked if anyone could help out. Brian can move the trailer in front of the shed before he goes out of town and Jeff McDowell will pull the day of the event.
- Mr. Wilson made one more comment that the Color Guard performed tonight at the basketball game. They were also set to perform on Friday at Creekmore and he believed they had another performance on March 2. They appear to be doing a great job this winter.
- Holli Berry asked Adrienne Edmonds if she would coordinate Trash Bag sales for this spring. Adrienne said she would. We would like to open this up to middle school band students so they can begin raising funds for band fees and trips.

Uniform Chair Report – Kim Schwartzman

- Kim Schwartzman not present. Kim Roberts has been working with Kim Schwartzman on getting marching uniform items turned in and accounted for. Kim Roberts states that there are quite a few items missing (i.e. hats, gauntlets). Asked if directors/president could send an e-mail blast out asking students to bring items in.
