Challenge Rules

- i. The *Challenger* is the person in the lower chair that initiates the challenge.
- ii. The Challengee is the person in the higher chair being challenged.
- iii. The Challenger is responsible to see that both people complete their portion of the form. They must also turn the form in to the appropriate band director.
- iv. The band director will post the assigned music and time of challenge on the bulletin board. Once posted for 24 hours, the director will assume the time is agreeable to both parties and they will be held responsible for that time.
- v. You do not have to challenge the person ahead of you, but if someone challenges you, you must accept or forfeit your chair.
- vi. Challenge times will be held before or after school, not during class time.
- vii. If a person loses a challenge, they must wait one week to re-challenge.
- viii. The band directors may call off challenges when necessary, such as in preparation for a performance.
- ix. If the first chair of a section in Concert Band wishes to challenge the last chair Symphonic Band member, they must first meet the benchmark score of the Symphonic Band audition material. Either director can score the audition material, but challenge forms should be turned in to Mr. Wilson.
