YES. Research shows that participation in band or orchestra will actually help your child's grades. On average, students who participate in school music organizations score 89 points higher on standardized tests like the SAT than students without musical coursework.

WILL MY CHILD HAVE TO GIVE UP ANY OTHER ACTIVITIES FOR BAND?

NO! Not only is participation in other school activities possible, it is highly ENCOURAGED!! Many students participate in activities outside of their school day, including clubs, sports, and music. Similar to athletics and academic classes, students do need to spend some time at home practicing in order to find optimum success.
